VIP Members build volunteer capacity at existing nonprofits, government agencies and schools (Partner Sites) that serve children, youth and families. They do this through: 1) building sustainable systems to track, support, manage, and train virtual or in person volunteers; 2) recruiting one-time and skills-based volunteers; and 3) raising funds to support the development of the volunteer program.

Primary Responsibilities

- Collaborate with CFS Executive Director and Farm Manager to implement and oversee the College Corps Fellowship Program at CFS in 2025-2026.
- Supervise College Corps Fellows: supervise shifts, manage scheduling, oversee day to day projects, liaison with partner program staff and CFS staff.
- Improve volunteer management infrastructure and systems including communication systems, record keeping, training, and volunteer leadership development.
- Lead volunteer events including weekly harvests, and bi-monthly Saturday work days.
- Participate in weekly check in meetings with CFS staff
